Benchmarks for Incoming Kindergarteners

State first and last name.
State age and birth date.
Identify eight basic colors: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, brown
and black.
Identify five basic shapes: circle, square, triangle, rectangle, and diamond.
Count to 20.
Isolate and identify numbers 1-20.
Write numbers 1-10.
Count objects to 10 with 1:1 correspondence.
Hold pencil correctly.
Write all capital letters correctly (see Letter Formation Handout).
Print first name using upper case for the first letter and lower case for
remaining letters (example: Susie, Robert).
Isolate letters, know all names and sounds.
Recite (not sing) the alphabet.
Hold scissors correctly, snip paper and cut on straight line.
Hop on one foot; left and right.
Bounce and catch a large rubber ball.
Zip jacket and pants; button clothes; buckle a belt; tie shoes.
Use bathroom independently and appropriately.
